Research paper abstracts will be peer-reviewed and evaluated for novelty, methodological rigour, and soundness of conclusions.

Research paper presentations will be grouped into themes per room; each speaker will have 10-15 minutes to present (depending on the number of accepted submissions) and time for Q&A will be reserved. Each accepted presenter must provide their presentation in the format of MS PowerPoint which will be loaded onto a communal laptop.
